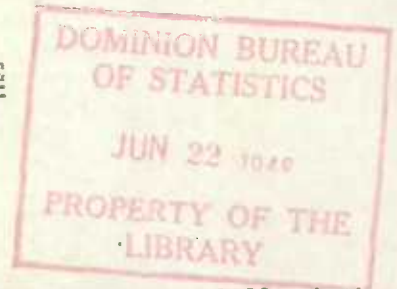

CONCRETE BUILDING BLOCKS AND CEMENT PIPEAPRIL, 1948

This report on concrete building materials covers production of 91 of the principal manufacturers which normally account for 85 per cent of the total for Canada. Output in April, included the following items: brick, 1,540,207 pieces; hollow blocks, 2,357,922 pieces; cinder blocks, 889,390 pieces; and pipe, 12,056 tons.
