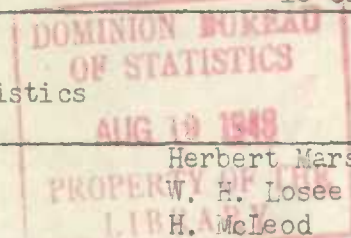

CONCRETE BUILDING BLOCKS AND CEMENT PIPEJUNE - 1948

This report on concrete building materials covers production of 109 of the principal manufacturers which normally account for 85 per cent of the total for Canada. Output in June included the following items: brick, 2,109,658 pieces; hollow blocks, 3,601,534 pieces; cinder blocks, 643,739 pieces; and pipe, 22,438 tons.
