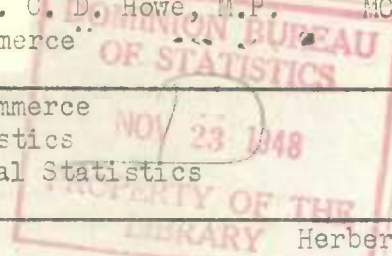

CONCRETE BUILDING BLOCKS AND CEMENT PIPE

JULY - 1948

This report on concrete building materials covers production of 110 of the principal manufacturers which normally account for 85-90 per cent of the total for Canada. Output in July included the following items: brick, 1,638,749 pieces; hollow blocks, 3,444,420 pieces; cinder blocks, 853,447 pieces; and pipe, 16,179 tons.
