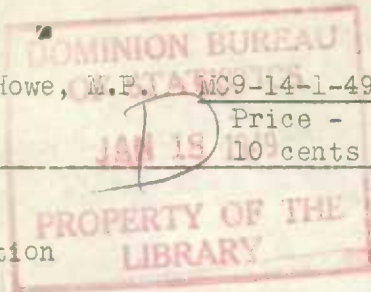

CONCRETE BUILDING BLOCKS AND CEMENT PIPE

SEPTEMBER, 1948

This report on concrete building materials covers production of 110 of the principal manufacturers which normally account for 85 per cent of the total for Canada. Output in September included the following items: brick, 2,262,126 pieces; hollow blocks, 3,054,614 pieces; cinder blocks, 750,143 pieces; and pipe, 17,989 tons.
