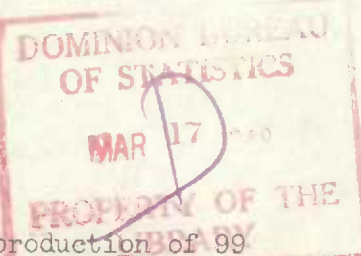

JANUARY - 1949

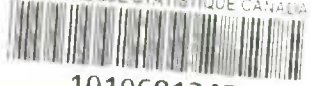


This report on concrete building materials covers production of 99 of the principal manufacturers which normally account for 85 per cent of the total for Canada. Output in January included the following items: brick, 1,726,438 pieces; hollow blocks, 2,066,154 pieces; cinder blocks, 1,010,816 pieces; chimney blocks, 6,537 pieces; and pipe, 6,876 tons.
