This report on concrete building materials covers production of 98 of the principal manufacturers which normally account for 85 per cent of the total for Canada. Output in February included the following items: brick, 860,863 pieces; hollow blocks, 2,023,272 pieces; cinder blocks, 1,008,654 pieces; chimney blocks, 6,830 pieces; and pipe, 8,021 tons.
