CONCRETE BUILDING BLOCKS AND CEMENT PIPE

MARCH - 1949



This report on concrete building materials covers production of 98 of the principal manufacturers which normally account for 85 per cent of the total for Canada. Output in March included the following items: brick, 1,739,990 pieces; hollow blocks, 2,592,019 pieces; cinder blocks, 908,976 pieces; chimney blocks, 6,036 pieces; and pipe, 8,341 tons.
