LIME PRODUCTION IN CANADA, OCTOBER, 1931.

Lime production in Canada during the past two months has shown an encouraging increase; September shipments were 5.7 per cent higher than the August total and the October production rose 4.3 per cent above the September sales. October records show that Canadian producers shipped 31,998 tons of lime as compared with 30,668 tons in September and 39,714 tons in October, 1930. Ontario's production during the month under review increased 17.9 per cent over the September total; Quebec, Manitoba and British Columbia operators reported a falling-off in shipments. Production of lime during the first ten months of 1931 aggregated 311,129 tons, a decline of 25.6 per cent from the total for the corresponding months of 1930.

Exports of lime from Canada in October amounted to 950 tons as compared with 1,182 tons exported in the previous month. Lime importations consisted of 52 tons from the United States; in September 6 tons were imported.
