LINE PRODUCTION IN CANADA, NOVEMBER, 1931.

The Canadian production of lime during November amounted to 29,628 tons, a decline of 7.4, per cent from the October total and 26.4 per cent from the November, 1930 shipments. Production during the month under review consisted of 12,786 tons from Ontario, 9,321 tons from Quebec, and the remainder from Nova Scotia, Manitoba, British Columbia, New Brunswick and Alberta. Shipments of lime to the end of November totalled 340,757 tons, a falling-off of 25.7, per cent from the production during the corresponding months of 1930.

Canadian producers exported 1,203 tons of lime as compared with 950 tons in October. The current month's exportations were principally to the United States.

Imports of lime into Canada amounted to $6\frac{1}{2}$ tons from the United States; in October. 52 tons were imported.
