LIME PRODUCTION IN CANADA, SEPTEMBER, 1931.

Canadian lime production recorded a 5.7 per cent increase in September. According to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa, shipments during the month totalled 30,668 tons while in August 29,010 tons were produced and in September last year 39,526 tons. The current month's lime production in Quebec showed an appreciable advance over the August total. Ontario's production continued at practically the same level as in the previous four months. Manitoba and British Columbia operators reported increased shipments during the month. The total Canadian production in the first nine months of 1931 was 279,131 tons or 26.3 per cent below the shipments of 378,497 tons for the corresponding period of 1930.

Canada exported 1,182 tons of line in September as against 878 tons in August. Total line importations during the month consisted of 6 tons from the United States; in the previous month 87 tons were imported.
