PRELIMINARY SUMMARY STATISTICS, 1933.

Manufactures of the non-metallic minerals in Canada during 1933 were valued at \$141,754,729, a decline of \$6 millions from the corresponding figure for last year which in turn was over \$33 millions lower than in 1931. Data for 1933 cover the business done by 1,138 plants which employed capital amounting to \$312,378,663. These establishments gave work to an average of 19,267 people who were paid \$21,866,913 in salaries and wages. Raw materials cost \$72,008,648 to which \$69,746,081 was added by manufacturing processes.

Imports during 1933 of non-metallic minerals and their products reached an appraised value of \$78,137,097 of which \$54,755,886 came from the United States and \$13,262,129 from the United Kingdom. Exports and re-exports of these materials during the same period totalled \$13,703,616 including \$8,305,226 to the United States and \$1,673,624 to the United Kingdom.
