IN CANADA, 1925.

Production of sand-lime brick in Canada in 1925 totalled 63,869 M. valued at \$781,555 as compared with 55,873 M. worth \$619,946 in 1924 according to a statement just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. Nine plants were in operation in 1925 of which 7 were in Ontario and 2 in Manitoba; in 1924 there were 10 establishments in Ontario, 1 in Manitoba and 1 in Saskatchewan.

Capital employed in the sand-lime brick industry in 1925 amounted to \$960,729 as against \$1,346,239 in the previous years; employees number 206 as against 236 in 1924 and materials used in manufacture cost \$130,155 in 1925 as compared with a corresponding figure of \$181,260 in 1924.
