THE SAND-LIME BRICK INDUSTRY IN CANADA, 1928.

Production from the sand-lime brick industry in Camada rose to a new high value during 1928 at \$1,112,466, according to a statement issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. In 1927 the output value for this industry was \$939,911 and in 1926 the total stood at \$629,672. Production in 1928 included 82,271,000 sand-lime brick worth \$1,038,510 as against a production of 72,864,000 valued at \$864,911 in 1927 and 50,282,000 at \$606,409 in 1926. The balance of the output in each year consisted mainly of hollow building blocks.

During the year under review, 11 plants were operating in Canada, 7 of which were located in Ontario, 2 in Quebec and 2 in Manitoba. These concerns employed a capital of \$1,916,060 and distributed \$352,311 in salaries and wages to an average of 270 workmen. Purchased materials cost \$322,027 and the value added by mamufacturing amounted to \$790,439.
