SALES OF LUBRICATING OILS AND GREASES, 1951

Sales of lubricating oils in Canada during 1951 amounted to 79,786,000 gallons of which $47,962,000$ gallons were for motor transport and tractor use, 904,000 gallons were for aircraft and $30,920,000$ gallons for industrial and other uses.

Sales of lubricating greases in 1951 totalled $76,681,000$ pounds, including $50,364,000$ pounds for automotive use and $26,317,000$ pounds for industrial use.

These figures were compiled from reports submitted by the principel wholesalers of petroleum oils and greases. Amounts imported direct by users or by retail outlets such as department stores are not included.
