# THE ADHESIVES INDUSTRY

1952

This report on the Adhesives Industry in Canada covers the operations of all factories which made glue, mucilage, paste or special adhesive cements as their chief products. In 1952 there were 30 establishments in this group, 16 being located in Ontario, 9 in Quebec, 4 in British Columbia and 1 in Manitoba.

Factory shipments by firms in the Adhesives Industry were valued at \$10,838,879 in 1952, a decline of 5.2 per cent from the 1951 total of \$11,437,037. The number of employees decreased 1.1 per cent to 706 while salaries and wages at \$2,128,897 were up 8.0 per cent from the \$1,971,906 paid in 1951. The cost of fuel and electricity at \$367,382 was lower by 0.6 per cent than in 1951 and the value of materials used directly in manufacturing processes was 2.8 per cent lower at \$6,106,121.

Output of adhesives during 1952, including small amounts from other industries, was as follows: linoleum cement, 12,679,000 pounds at \$706,000; rubber cement, 648,000 gallons at \$1,488,000; bone and hide glue, 5,140,000 pounds at \$1,666,000; casein glue, 861,000 pounds at \$260,000; flexible glue, 2,084,000 pounds at \$509,000; fish glue, 1,671,000 pounds at \$456,000; synthetic resin glue, 17,300,000 pounds at \$2,150,000; vegetable glues, 19,956,000 pounds at \$2,051,000; mucilage and paste valued at \$746,000 and miscellaneous adhesives at \$1,458,000. The total value of all adhesives, including mucilage and paste, was \$11,490,000 in 1952, compared with \$10,924,000 in 1951 and \$9,130,000 in 1950.

Note: Data presented in this bulletin for 1952 under the heading of "Production" actually represent "Factory Shipments" and therefore, are not exactly comparable with previous years.
