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THE COAL TAR DISTILLATION INDUSTRY IN CANADA, 1929.

Output from the coal tar distillation industry in Canada during 1929 amounted to \$3,818,050. Ten tar distillation plants were in operation during 1929. The Dominion Tar and Chemical Co. Ltd., operated distilleries at Sydney, N.S.; Ville la Salle, P.Q., Toronto, Ont., Sault Ste. Marie, Ont.; and St. Boniface Man.; the Barrett Company, Ltd., had units in operation at Montreal, P.Q., Toronto, Ont.; Winnipeg, Man., and Vancouver, B.C.; and the Hamilton Tar Products Company, Ltd., worked a plant at Hamilton, Ont. Capital employed by these concerns was reported at \$4,982,333, employees numbered 242, materials cost \$2,658,555 and products sold for \$3,818,050 at the works.
