Production from the inks, dycs and colnmes irdustiv ir Canada during 1928 was valued at $\$ 3,334,168$, or $\$ 112,491$ above the value roporied for 1927 , accordiag to data compiled by the Iominion Burceu of Statistics ct Ottava.

Of the 28 plants in this group, 16 made priatine inks and printers' rollers, 6 produced des and colours and 6 reported miting ivits and adhesives as their main products. The factorics were idistri buted provincially as follom: Ontario, 16; quebec, 5; British Columbia, 3; Manjtoba, 2; and New Bzuns:rick, 1 .

C pital employed was reported at $\$ 3,052,322$; emplcyees mombered 437 ; salaries anci wagos amountod to $\$ 805,373$; materials used cost $\$ 1,2 \dot{\prime} 2,603$, and the valuo added by manfacturins was $\$ 2,151,565$.

Imports of dveing and tanning materials into Canada in 1928 amounted in value to $\$ 4,093.581$; imnorts of printing inks were worth $\$ 311,985$; writing inks, $\$ 41,662$, and mucilase and paste, $\$ 160,443$.
