## THE INKS INDUSTRY, 1945

Output of printing inks ili 1345 was reported at $12,502,374$ pounds valued at $\$ 3,998,471$ as against $10,432,495$ pounns at $\$ 3,582,309$ for 1044 , and the value of writing inks was $\$ 416,924$ compared with $\$ 448,279$ in 1944.

Printing inks were manufactured in 16 ditferent plants in 1945, distributed, by provinces, as follows: 3 in quebec, 12 in Ontario and 1 in Eritish Columbia. The total production of these concerns was valued at $\$ 4,255,345$, including some printers' rollers and other products as well as printing inks. Mmployees numbered 487 and salaries and wages fon the year anounted to $\$ 1,234,123$. Haterials for manufacturing cost $\$ 1,759,174$ and tuel and electricity cost $\$ 40,152$ delivered at the works. Ontput included $12,485,02 \%$ pounds of printing inks at $\$ 3,983,278$, printers' rollers at $\$ 240,933$, and miscellaneous products worth $\$ 31,134$.

Four other establishments-1 in Manitoba, 2 in Quebec, and 1 in New Bruns-wick-made printers' rollers but no inks. Only 17 workers were employeed in these plants and their total outpilt, valued at $\$ 61,792$, included rollers at $\$ 57,640$. Including the output from oncerns which made printing inks as well as rollers, the total production of the latter was $\$ 298,573$ in 1945.

Writing inks were made in 3 foantories in Quebec, 6 in Ontario, 1 in Nanitoba and 1 in British Columbia, a total of 10 estabishments, which employed 137 persons and made goods valued at $\$ 720,031$. Froduction included writing inks at $\$ 416,924$, mucilage and paste at $\$ 88,900$, and miscellaneous articles at $\$ 214,207$.

For the entire group, there were 31 establishments which employed 641 workers and produced goods valued at $\$ 5,(337,168$.

Imports of inks in 1945 included 507,946 pounds of printing inks valued at. $\$ 266,407 ; 11,559$ pounds of rotogravure inks at $\$ 5,298$ and writing inks valued at $\$ 39,342$.
