THE INKS INDUSTRY, 1947

Output of printing inks in 1947 was reported at 17,843,861 pounds valued at \$5,883,670 as against 15,891,841 pounds at \$5,221,522 for 1946, and the value of writing inks was \$267,348 compared with \$310,230 in 1946.

Printing inks were manufactured in 19 different plants in 1947, distributed, by provinces, as follows: 4 in Quebec, 14 in Ontario, and 1 in British Columbia. The total production of these concerns was valued at \$6,265,591, including some printers' rollers and other products as well as printing inks. Employees numbered 592 and salaries and wages for the year amounted to \$1,275,197. Materials for manufacturing cost \$2,793,163 and fuel and electricity cost \$53,611 delivered at the works. Output included 17,826,391 pounds of printing inks at \$5,865,811, printers' rollers at \$338,915, and miscellaneous products worth \$60,865.

Four other establishments--l in Manitoba, 2 in Quebec, and l in New Brunswick--made printers' rollers but no inks. Only 22 workers were employed in these plants and their total output, valued at \$88,909 included rollers at \$84,911. Including the output from concerns which made printing inks as well as rollers, the total production of the latter was \$423,826 in 1947.

Writing inks were made in 3 factories in Quebec, 4 in Ontario, 1 in Manitoba and 1 in British Columbia, a total of 9 establishments, which employed 105 persons and made goods valued at \$667,766. Production included writing inks at \$267,348, mucilage and paste at \$69,501, and miscellaneous articles at \$330,917.

For the entire group, there were 32 establishments which employed 719 workers and produced goods valued at \$7,022,266.

Imports of inks in 1947 included 883,757 pounds of printing inks valued at \$375,442; 27,520 pounds of rotogravure inks at \$12,919, and writing inks valued at \$29,793. Inks
