## THE INKS INDUSTRY - 1948

Output of printing inks in 1948 was reported at $20,273,748$ pounds valued at $\$ 7,014,757$ as against $17,843,861$ pounds at $\$ 5,883,670$ for 1947 , and the value of writing inks was $\$ 319,331$ compared with $\$ 267,348$ in 1947.

Printing inks were manufactured in 18 different plants in 1948, distributed, by provinces, as follows: 4 in Quebec, 13 in Ontario, and 1 in British Columbia. The total production of these concerns was valued at $\$ 7,425,577$ including some printers' rollers and other products as well as printing inks. Employees numbered 524 and salaries and wages for the year amounted to $\$ 1,505,156$. Materials for manufacturing cost $\$ 3,417,676$ and fuel and electricity cost $\$ 61,692$ delivered at the works. Output included $20,254,348$ pounds of printing inks at $\$ 6,994,907$ printers' rollers at $\$ 383,995$ and miscellaneous products worth $\$ 46,675$.

Five other establishments -- 1 in Manitoba, 1 in Ontario, 2 in Quebec, and 1 in New Brunswick -- made printers' rollers but no inks. Only 23 workers mere employed in these plants and their total output woe - Mai at \$111,238. including the output from concerns which made printing inks as well as rollers, the total production of the latter was $\$ 495,233$ in 1948.

Writing inks were made in 3 factories in Quebec, 4 in Ontario, 1 in Manitoba and 1 in British Columbia, a total of 9 establishments, which employed 95 persons and made goods valued at $\$ 750,765$. Production included writing inks at $\$ 319,331$; mucilage and paste at $\$ 101,045$; and miscellaneous articles at $\$ 330,389$.

For the entire group, there were 32 establishments which employed 642 workers and produced goods valued at $\$ 8,287,580$.

Imports of inks in 1945 included $1,213,243$ pounds of printing inks valued at $\$ 510,491 ; 125,265$ pounds of rotogravure inks at $\$ 48,119$ and writing inks valued at $\$ 39,508$.
