THE MEDICINAL AND PHARMACEUTICAL PREPARATIONS INDUSTRY IN CANADA, 1928.

Production in Canada during 1928 of patent and proprietary medicines, pharmaceuticals and similar commodities amounted in value to \$17,224,351, an increase of nearly a million dollars over the total for 1927 and a higher total than in any other year.

Leading products of this industry were patent and proprietary preparations, \$7,348,058; pharmaceuticals, \$5,680,599; and toilet preparations, \$1,564,577. Capital invested totalled \$17,427,506; employees numbered 2,667 and payments in salaries and wages reached \$3,375,024. Of the 140 reporting plants, 82 were located in Ontario, 44 in Quebec, 5 in Manitoba, 4 in British Columbia, 2 in each of Nova Scotia and New Brunswick, and 1 in Alberta. Individual pharmacists throughout the country who compound medicines but who, in the main conduct a retail business, are not included. Production in Ontario totalled \$11,268,846; in Quebec, \$4,439,303; in Manitoba, \$1,261,720; in British Columbia, \$101,485; and in New Brunswick, Alberta, and Nova Scotia, \$152,997.
