THE MEDICINAL AND PHARMACEUTICAL PREPARATIONS INDUSTRY, 1952

Factory shipments by the manufacturing plants in Canada which were engaged chiefly in making patent and proprietary medicines, pharmaceuticals and similar commodities were valued at \$88,022,387 in 1952.

Of the 213 factories in this group in 1952, 97 were located in Ontario, 91 in Quebec, 9 in Manitoba, 8 in British Columbia, 3 in Nova Scotia, 2 in Alberta, 2 in Newfoundland and 1 in New Brunswick. The total number of employees in 1952 was 7,457, compared with 7,481 in the previous year, and payments in salaries and wages amounted to \$20,481,873 as against \$18,917,850 in 1951.
