

THE MEDICINAL AND PHARMACEUTICAL PREPARATIONS INDUSTRY, 1955

Factory shipments by the manufacturing plants in Canada which were engaged chiefly in making patent and proprietary medicines, pharmaceuticals and similar commodities were valued at \$108,121,734 in 1955, an increase of 11 per cent over the comparable figure of \$97,395,558 in 1954.

Of the 210 factories in this group in 1955, 93 were located in Quebec, 92 in Ontario, 9 in British Columbia, 7 in Manitoba, 3 in Nova Scotia, 3 in Newfoundland, 2 in Alberta and 1 in New Brunswick. The total number of employees in 1955 was 7,629 compared with 7,380 in the previous year, and payments in salaries and wages amounted to \$23,937,050 as against \$22,648,147 in 1954. Plants in Ontario

accounted for 49 per cent of the Canadian output, while concerns in Quebec produced 48 per cent.

The concerns in this industry make medicinals and pharmaceuticals as their main products, but they also manufacture other lines, such as toilet preparations, as a secondary part of their business. On the other hand, some companies which have been classified to other industrial groups make some medicinal preparations as minor products. The total Canadian output of medicinals, pharmaceuticals and biologicals, from all industries, amounted in value to \$100,878,000 in 1955 compared with \$90,799,000 in 1954 and \$87,098,000 in 1953.

Note: Figures for value added by manufacture, shown in Table 1, prior to 1952 were obtained by subtracting the cost of materials used, including fuel and electricity, from the value of production. In 1952 the gross value of production was replaced by value of factory shipments, f.o.b. plant. As no information on inventory change is available for 1952 and 1953, value added figures for these years were obtained by subtracting from the value of shipments the cost of materials, fuel and electricity. In 1954 and 1955 information on the value of year-end inventory holdings at plant and plant warehouses was collected as part of the annual Census of Industry and information thus made available was taken into account in calculating the value added figures for 1954 and 1955.

(b) Beginning with 1954, information on the value of year-end inventory holdings at plant and plant warehouses is being collected as part of the annual Census of Industry. These data were formerly collected by a separate survey. The summarized results for the Medicinal and Pharmaceutical Preparations Industry for the year under review are shown in the above table.

(c) The opening inventory for 1955 does not necessarily agree with the closing inventory for 1954 because of revisions such as the addition of new plants, the transfer of plants to other industries and plants going out of business. However, the value added figures for the previous year have not been recalculated to allow for the revisions mentioned above.


