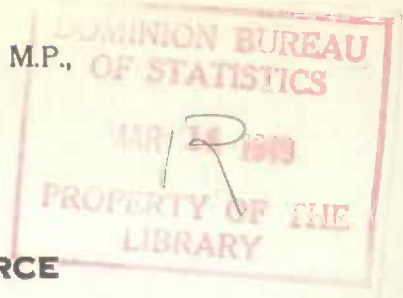

THE SOAPS, WASHING COMPOUNDS AND CLEANING PREPARATIONS INDUSTRY - 1947

In 1947 a total of 166 factories in Canada made soaps, washing compounds or cleaning preparations as their main products. Production from these works was valued at \$53,200,468 or 39 per cent more than the output of \$38,274,818 from the 150 establishments in this industry in 1946. Employees numbered 3,262 compared with 3,219 in 1946; salaries and wages amounted to \$6,804,806 against \$6,213,581 in the previous year.

Fifty-three of the plants were engaged primarily in the manufacture of soaps, 23 being in Ontario, 13 in Quebec, 3 in Alberta, 4 in Manitoba and 10 in British Columbia. These establishments reported 2,472 workers with production valued at \$46,573,770.

Sixty-four establishments made washing compounds as their main product, 30 being located in Quebec, 24 in Ontario, 7 in British Columbia, 1 in Alberta, 1 in Manitoba and 1 in Nova Scotia. Their output was valued at \$3,550,455 and employees numbered 491 compared with production at \$2,411,702 and employees at 443 for the 56 plants reporting in this division for 1946. Javelle water and sodium hypochlorite were the chief products.

Forty-nine establishments made cleaning preparations as their main products in 1947. Twenty-six plants were located in Ontario, 10 in Quebec, 3 in Manitoba, 3 in Alberta and 7 in British Columbia. Production amounted to \$3,076,243 and the number of employees was 299 while the corresponding data for 1946 showed 45 plants employing 313 people and output valued at \$3,153,547. The main products were cleaning powders, hand cleaners and drain pipe cleaners.

Tables 1 to 10 inclusive of this report refer only to the Soaps, Washing Compounds and Cleaning Preparations Industry, which includes the firms reporting these lines as their chief products. Small quantities of these commodities were made also by concerns which have been classified to other industrial groups, so Table 11 has been added to show the total Canadian production. This table shows that the output for Canada during 1947 included the following: 18,940 tons of toilet soaps valued at \$9,128,628; 18,885 tons of bar laundry and household soaps at \$4,262,146; 18,583 tons of soap chips and flakes at \$5,637,456; 44,131 tons of soap powders at \$11,386,702; 1,671 tons of textile and mill soaps at \$466,253; 914 tons of castile soap at \$274,924; 761 tons of shaving soaps and creams at \$1,486,970; 4,994 tons of liquid soaps at \$1,296,449; 2,871 tons of soft soaps at \$539,946 cleaning and scouring powders, etc., at \$1,959,651 and javelle water valued at \$3,248,994.
