THE SOAPS, WASHING COMPOUNDS AND CLEANING PREPARATIONS INDUSTRY

1949

In 1949 a total of 143 factories in Canada made soaps, washing compounds or cleaning preparations as their main products. Production from these works was valued at \$62,398,211 or 7.7 per cent less than the output of \$67,586,991 from the 149 establishments in this industry in 1948. Employees numbered 3,637 compared with 3,351 in 1948; salaries and wages amounted to \$9,373,882 against \$8,124,916 in the previous year.

Forty-six of the plants were engaged primarily in the manufacture of soaps, 23 being in Ontario, 12 in Quebec, 2 in Alberta, 3 in Manitoba and 6 in British Columbia. These establishments reported 2,896 workers with production valued at \$53,736,951.

Fifty-four establishments made washing compounds as their main product, 22 being located in Quebec, 21 in Ontario, 4 in British Columbia, 3 in Newfoundland, 2 in Alberta and 2 in Manitoba. Their output was valued at \$4,513,387 and employees numbered 440 compared with production at \$3,894,058 and employees at 485 for the 54 plants reporting in this division for 1948. Javelle water and sodium hypochlorite were the chief products.

Forty-three establishments made cleaning preparations as their main products in 1949; 24 plants were located in Ontario, 10 in Quebec, 4 in Manitoba, 1 in Alberta and 4 in British Columbia.

Production amounted to \$4,147,873 and the number of employees was 301 while the corresponding data for 1948 showed 46 plants employing 277 people and output valued at \$3,945,742. The main products were cleaning powders, hand cleaners and drain pipe cleaners.

Tables 1 to 5 and 7 and 10 of this report refer only to the Soaps, Washing Compounds and Cleaning Preparations Industry, which includes the firms reporting these lines as their chief products. Small quantities of these commodities were made also by concerns which have been classified to other industrial groups, so Table 6 has been added to show the total Canadian production. This table shows that the output for Canada during 1949 included the following: 18,154 tons of toilet soaps valued at \$10,663,162; 15,868 tons of bar laundry and household soaps at \$4,512,220; 15,941 tons of soap chips and flakes at \$5,112,343; 46,119 tons of soap powders at \$13,570,248; 1,274 tons of textile and mill soaps at \$359,577; 703 tons of castile soap at \$240,863; 725 tons of shaving soaps and creams at \$1,744,681; 5,138 tons of liquid soaps at \$1,285,661; 1,724 tons of soft soaps at \$349,299; cleaning and scouring powders, etc., at \$2,332,764 and javelle water valued at \$4,449,802. Production of synthetic detergents amounted to 18,613 tons valued at \$7,784,380.

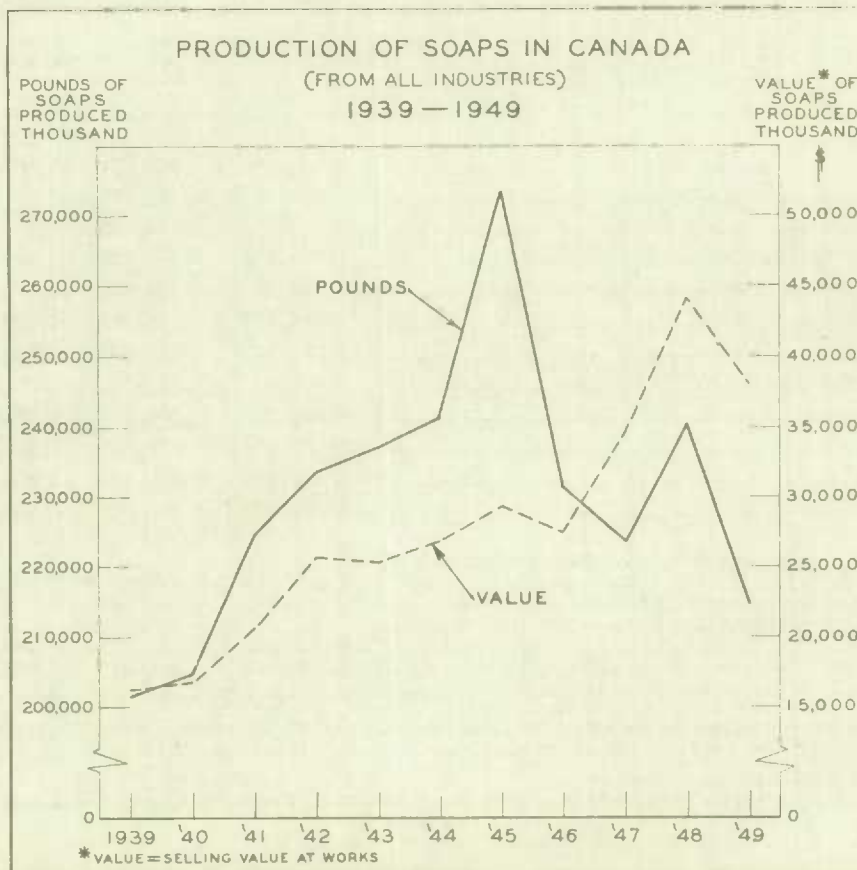
