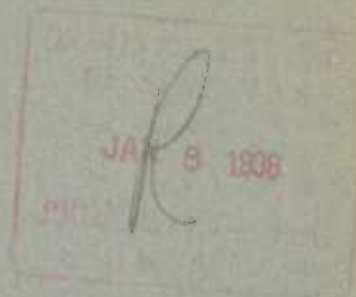

CHEMICALS AND ALLIED PRODUCTS GROUP

THE TOILET PREPARATIONS INDUSTRY, 1936

The Toilet Preparations Industry, as reviewed in the present bulletin, includes only those concerns which manufacture, as their chief products, such articles as toilet creams, hair tonics, face powders, tooth paste, perfumes, etc. In addition, there is a considerable number of manufacturers who make toilet preparations as a minor part of their output and are therefore classed in other industrial groups. Chief of these are some soap producers and the makers of patent medicines and pharmaceuticals. Only about 70 per cent of the Canadian output of toilet essentials is produced in the Toilet Preparations Industry as it is defined for purposes of this report. However, statistics for this industry are shown separately as they are important as being representative of the manufacture of toilet preparations. In order to make the production figures complete, tables 12 to 14 are appended to show the total output of toilet preparations from all industries.

In 1936, a total of 87 plants were included in this industry, 55 being located in Ontario, 23 in Quebec, 3 in Manitoba, 4 in British Columbia, and 1 in each of Saskatchewan and Alberta. Output from these concerns was valued at \$6,544,377, including \$5,266,994 for toilet preparations and \$1,277,383 for other products. Capital employed in manufacturing operations amounted to \$5,624,306, employees numbered 1,171, and salaries and wages totalled \$1,199,913.

Imports of toilet preparations into Canada were valued at \$430,730 in 1936 compared with \$420,819 in 1935. Approximately 51 per cent of the imports came from the United States, 30 per cent from the United Kingdom, 16 per cent from France, and nearly 3 per cent from other countries.

Total production of toilet preparations in Canada, from all industries, was valued at \$7,415,522 at factory prices in 1936. Comparative figures for 1935 and 1934 amounted to \$7,120,316 and \$6,745,513, respectively.
