ANNUAL INDUSTRY REPORTCHEMICALS AND ALLIED PRODUCTS GROUPTHE TOILET PREPARATIONS INDUSTRY, 1945

Production from the Toilet Preparations Industry was valued at \$15,510,204 in 1943 compared with \$12,201,445 in 1942 and \$10,155,763 in 1941.

In the annual census of manufacturing establishments in Canada the operating firms are arranged in a number of industrial groups to which the various factories are classified in accordance with the nature of their main products. Under this arrangement the Toilet Preparations Industry includes all establishments which are occupied chiefly in making perfumes, toilet waters, face creams, tooth pastes, etc., but this industry accounts for only about 83 per cent of the Canadian output of toilet preparations as a number of concerns in other industries make this class of goods as a minor or secondary part of their business. In Tables 1 to 10 of this report the data are for the Toilet Preparations Industry as defined for census purposes, but Tables 11 to 13 have been added to show the total output of toilet preparations regardless of the industry in which produced.

In 1943 a total of 87 establishments were included in this industry, 52 being located in Ontario, 27 in Quebec, 4 in Manitoba, 3 in British Columbia and 1 in Saskatchewan. Output from these concerns totalled \$15,510,204 including \$12,991,776 for toilet preparations and \$2,518,428 for other products. Capital employed in manufacturing operations amounted to \$9,989,810, employees numbered 1,889, and salaries and wages amounted to \$2,386,033.

The total production of toilet preparations in Canada, from all industries amounted to \$18,629,034 at factory prices in 1945. In 1942 the comparative value was \$13,434,424 and in 1941 it was \$11,893,994.

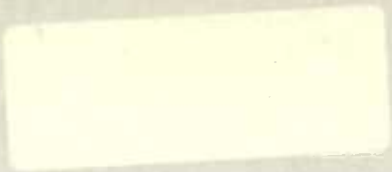
