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ANNUAL INDUSTRY REPORTCHEMICALS AND ALLIED PRODUCTS GROUPTHE TOILET PREPARATIONS INDUSTRY, 1944

Production from the Toilet Preparations Industry was valued at \$17,811,721 in 1944 compared with \$15,510,204 in 1943 and \$12,201,445 in 1942.

In the annual census of manufacturing establishments in Canada the operating firms are arranged in a number of industrial groups to which the various factories are classified in accordance with the nature of their main products. Under this arrangement the Toilet Preparations Industry includes all establishments which are occupied chiefly in making perfumes, toilet waters, face creams, tooth pastes, etc., but this industry accounts for only about 73 per cent of the Canadian output of toilet preparations as a number of concerns in other industries make this class of goods as a minor or secondary part of their business. In Tables 1 to 9 of this report the data are for the Toilet Preparations Industry as defined for census purposes, but Table 10 to 12 have been added to show the total output of toilet preparations regardless of the industry in which produced.

In 1943 a total of 95 establishments were included in this industry, 57 being located in Ontario, 29 in Quebec, 4 in Manitoba, 4 in British Columbia and 1 in Saskatchewan. Output from these concerns totalled \$17,811,721, including \$14,633,714 for toilet preparations and \$3,178,007 for other products. Employees numbered 2,096 and salaries and wages amounted to \$2,798,410.

The total production of toilet preparations in Canada from all industries amounted to \$20,095,208 at factory prices in 1944. In 1943 the comparative value was \$18,629,034 and in 1942 it was \$13,434,424.
