Production from the Toilet Preparations Industry was valued at \$20,117,113 in 1946 compared with \$18,992,908 in 1945 and \$17,811,721 in 1944.

In the annual census of manufacturing establishments in Canada the operating firms are arranged in a number of industrial groups to which the various factories are classified in accordance with the nature of their main products. Under this arrangement, the Toilet Preparations Industry includes all establishments which are occupied chiefly in making perfumes, toilet waters, face creams, tooth pastes, etc., but this industry accounts for only about 68 per cent of the Canadian output of toilet preparations as a number of concerns in other industries make this class of goods as a minor or secondary part of their business. In Tables 1 to 8 of this report the data are for the Toilet Preparations Industry as defined for census purposes, but Tables 9 to 11 have been added to show the total output of toilet preparations regardless of the industry in which produced.

In 1946 a total of 91 establishments were included in this industry, 53 being located in Ontario, 27 in Quebec, 5 in Manitoba, 3 in British Columbia and 2 in Saskatchewan. Output from these concerns totalled \$20,117,113, including \$16,780,451 for toilet preparations and \$3,336,662 for other products. Employees numbered 1,995 and salaries and wages amounted to \$2,729,367.

The total production of toilet preparations in Canada, from all industries amounted to \$24,758,564 at factory prices in 1946. In 1945 the comparative value was \$22,037,891 and in 1944 it was \$20,095,208.
