## THE TOILYT PREPARATIONS INDUSTRL -1948

Production from the Toilet Preparation Industry was valued at $\$ 17,044,566$ in 1948 compared with $\$ 16,888,213$ in 1947 and $\$ 20,117,113$ in 1946.

In the annal census of manufacturing establishments in Canada, the operating firms are arranged in a number of industrial groups to which the various factories are classified in eccordance with the nature of their main products. Under this arrangement, the Toilet Preparations Industry includes all establishments which are occupied chiefly in making perfumes, tollet waters, face craams, tooth pastes, etc., but this industry accounts for only about 65 per cent of the Canadian output of toilet preparations as a number of concerns in other industries make this class of goods as a minor or secondary part of their business. In Tables 1 to 4 and Table 8 of this report the data are for the Toilet Preparations Industry as defined for census purposes, but Tables 5 and 6 bave been added to show the total ontput of tollet preparations regardless of the industry in which produced.

In 1948 there were 90 establishments in this industry, 55 being located in Ontario, 28 in Quebec, 3 in Manitoba, 3 in British Columbia, and 1 in Saskatchewan. Output froe these concerns totalled $\$ 17,044,566$, including $\$ 13,677,208$ for tollet preparations and $\$ 3,367,358$ for other products. Employees numbered 1,658 and aslaries and wages amounted to $\$ 2,749,569$.

The total production of toilet preparations in Canada, from all industries amounted to $\$ 20,972,092$ at factory prices in 1948. In 1947 the comparative value was $\$ 22,481,068$ and in 1946 it was \$24,758,564.
