# THE TOILET PREPARATIONS INDUSTRY

## 1950

Production from the Toilet Preparations Industry was valued at \$20,950,830 in 1950 compared with \$19,047,435 in 1949 and \$17,044,566 in 1948.

In the annual census of manufacturing establishments in Canada, the operating firms are arranged in a number of industrial groups to which the various factories are classified in accordance with the nature of their main products. Under this arrangement, the Toilet Preparations Industry includes all establishments which are occupied chiefly in making perfumes, toilet waters, face creams, tooth pastes, etc., but in 1950 this industry actually accounted for only about 62 per cent of the Canadian output of toilet preparations as a number of concerns in other industries made this class of goods as a minor or secondary part of their business. In Tables 1 to 4 and Table 8 of this report the data are for the Toilet

Preparations Industry as defined for census purposes, but Tables 5 and 6 have been added to show the total output of toilet preparations regardless of the industry in which produced

In 1950 there were 98 establishments in this industry, 60 being located in Ontario, 30 in Quebec, 3 in Manitoba, 4 in British Columbia, and 1 in Saskatchewan. Output from these concerns totalled \$20,950,830, including \$18,418,191 for toilet preparations and \$2,532,639 for other products. Employees numbered 1,862 and salaries and wages amounted to \$3,423,935.

The total production of toilet preparations in Canada, from all industries amounted to \$30,046,000 at factory prices in 1950. In 1949 the comparative value was \$27,102,000 and in 1948 it was \$20,972,000
