

# THE TOILET PREPARATIONS INDUSTRY

1951

In the annual census of manufacturing establishments in Canada the operating firms are arranged in a number of industrial groups to which the various factories are classified in accordance with the nature of their main products. Under this arrangement, the Toilet Preparations Industry includes all establishments which are occupied chiefly in making perfumes, toilet waters, face creams, tooth pastes, etc., but in 1951 this industry actually accounted for only about 62 per cent of the Canadian output of toilet preparations as a number of concerns in other industries made this class of goods as a minor or secondary part of their business. In Tables 1 to 4 and Table 8 of this report the data are for the Toilet Preparations Industry as defined for census

Production from the Toilet Preparations Industry was valued at \$22,535,080 in 1951 compared with \$20,950,830 in 1950 and \$19,047,435 in 1949.

purposes, but Tables 5 and 6 have been added to show the total output of toilet preparations regardless of the industry in which produced.

In 1951 there were 97 establishments in this industry, 55 being located in Ontario, 33 in Quebec, 3 in Manitoba, 5 in British Columbia and 1 in Saskatchewan. Output from these concerns totalled \$22,535,080, including \$19,267,691 for toilet preparations and \$3,267,389 for other products. Employees numbered 1,800 and salaries and wages amounted to \$3,775,166.

The total production of toilet preparations in Canada from all industries amounted to \$30,873,000 at factory prices in 1951. In 1950 the comparable value was \$29,147,000 and in 1949 it was \$27,102,000.
