THE TOILET PREPARATIONS INDUSTRY

1952

Factory shipments from the Toilet Preparations Industry were valued at \$27,059,783 in 1952 compared with \$22,535,080 in 1951 and \$20,950,830 in 1950.

In the annual census of manufacturing establishments in Canada the operating firms are arranged in a number of industrial groups to which the various factories are classified in accordance with the nature of their main products. Under this arrangement, the Toilet Preparations Industry includes all establishments which are occupied chiefly in making perfumes, toilet waters, face creams, tooth pastes, etc., but in 1952 this industry actually accounted for only about 64 per cent of the Canadian output of toilet preparations as a number of concerns in other industries made this class of goods as a minor or secondary part of their business. In Tables 1 to 4

and 8 and 9 of this report the data are for the Toilet Preparations Industry as defined for Census purposes but Tables 5 and 6 have been added to show the total output of toilet preparations regardless of the industry in which produced.

In 1952 there were 101 establishments in this industry, 60 being located in Ontario, 33 in Quebec, 4 in British Columbia, 3 in Manitoba and 1 in Saskatchewan. Output from these concerns totalled \$27,059,783, including \$23,819,339 for toilet preparations and \$3,240,444 for other products. Employees numbered 1,870 and salaries and wages amounted to \$4,244,777.

Factory shipments of toilet preparations from all industries were valued at \$37,281,000 at factory prices in 1952. In 1951 the comparable value was \$30,873,000, and in 1950 it was \$29,147,000.

Note: Data presented in this bulletin for 1952 under the heading of "Production" actually represent "Factory Shipments" and therefore, are not exactly comparable with previous years.
