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## CHEMICALS AND ALLIED PRODUCTS

THE WOOD DISTILL ION INDUSTRY, 1932.
Production of wood distillates in Canada during 1932 mas valued at $\$ 607,394$ as compared with $\$ 700,937$ in 1931. Only 4 carbonizing plants and refinery were ia operation. Charcoal, grey acetate of lime, wood alcohol, acetic acid, formaldehyde and columbian spirits were the main products.

The number of employees in 1932 was 98 and payments in salaries and wages amounted to $\$ 98,839$. Capital employed was reported at $\$ 1,572,391$. Fuel and electricity cost $\$ 71,970$ and materials for manufacturing, mostly hardwoods, cost \$320,457 at the works.
