

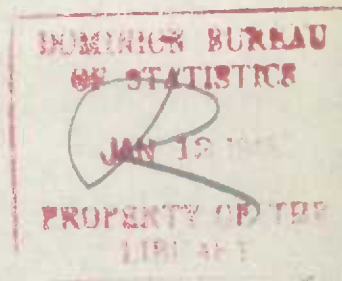

THE BROOM, BRUSH AND MOP INDUSTRY IN CANADA, 1943.

A report on the broom, brush and mop industry in Canada during the calendar year 1943 is presented herewith.

In that year there were 88 establishments in operation which were located by provinces as follows: Nova Scotia 1 New Brunswick 1 Quebec 34 Ontario 38 Manitoba 6 Saskatchewan 1 Alberta 1 and British Columbia 6. To avoid divulging information concerning individual establishments, it has been necessary to combine statistics for the provinces of Nova Scotia, New Brunswick, Saskatchewan and Alberta which are shown throughout the report as "Other Provinces."

These 88 factories had a total capital investment of \$6,155,907 provided employment to 2,236 persons who received \$2,478,173 in salaries and wages. The sum of \$4,539,386 was expended for materials used, whilst the total output was valued at \$9,350,190

The principal items of production in order of importance as represented by the total selling value at the factory were; brooms, - corn \$1,598,026, paint brushes \$1,527,427, brushes for industrial use \$1,105,672 and mops, all kinds, \$949,350. For details of products made, see Table 1.

Compared with the previous year there was an increase of \$23,218 in the capital invested, 203 in the number of persons employed, \$321,350 in the salaries and wages paid, \$234,572 in the cost of materials used, \$388,545 in the gross value of the products and \$39,740 in the value added by manufacture.

Detailed statistics of production, materials used, capital, employment, power and fuel consumption are given in the tables following.
