CONSUMER PRICE INDEX RECLASSIFIED BY GOODS AND SERVICES

A revised supplementary classification system, entitled "C.P.I. Reclassified by Goods and Services" has been developed as a feature of the latest revision to the Consumer Price Index.(1)

This supplementary classification introduces an improved framework for regrouping the items which comprise the Index. In it, all items in the C.P.I. have been reclassified into two major categories — goods and services — according to their most characteristic or dominant attribute. The goods component has been subdivided into three categories: durable, semi-durable, and non-durable goods, according to expected average useful lifetime criteria. Services, on the other hand, have been sub-divided according to broad functional categories.

The composition and the relative importance of the groups which make up the revised C.P.I. Reclassified by Goods and Services are shown in Table 1, with weights expressed in terms of 1967 quantities valued in 1967 prices. To provide users with continuous series for this supplementary classification on an historical basis, the 1957-weighted Consumer Price Index (1961=100) has been regrouped and calculated according to the new classification system. These series, on a monthly and on an annual average basis from 1961 to April 1973, are contained in Table 2.

To correspond with the method by which the revised C.P.I., in its regular classification, is linked with the previously published series, the C.P.I. Reclassified by Goods and Services is likewise linked at April 1973 to provide continuous series on a 1961=100 time base. The previously published supplementary price indexes, now replaced, terminated in April 1973.

INDICE DES PRIX À LA CONSOMMATION RECLASSE PAR BIENS ET SERVICES

Lors de la dernière refonte de l'indice des prix à la consommation, on a élaboré un système supplémentaire de classification révisé portant le nom de "I.P.C. reclassé par biens et services"(1).

Cette classification supplémentaire regroupe dans un cadre amélioré les éléments de l'indice. En effet, tous ces éléments ont été reclasés dans deux grandes catégories, soit la catégorie des biens et celle des services, suivant leur caractère le plus distinctif ou dominant. La catégorie des biens présente trois sous-catégories (biens durables, biens semi-durables, biens non durables) déterminées en fonction de la durée utile moyenne prévisible. D'autre part, on a réparti les services suivant quelques grandes catégories fonctionnelles.

Le Tableau 1 montre la composition et l'importance relative des groupes composant l'I.P.C. révisé reclassé par biens et services. Les poids utilisés se fondent sur les volumes quantitatifs de 1967 évalués selon les prix de cette même année. Afin de permettre aux utilisateurs de tirer parti de cette classification supplémentaire pour des études rétrospectives du coût de la vie, on a reconstruit d'après le nouveau système de classification l'indice des prix à la consommation à poids de 1957 (1961=100). Ces séries sur une base mensuelle et selon les moyennes annuelles de 1961 à avril 1973 figurent au Tableau 2.

Conformément à la méthode suivant laquelle l'I.P.C. révisé (classification ordinaire) est lié aux séries jusque-là publiées, l'I.P.C. reclassé par biens et services est raccordé en avril 1973 aux indices précédents de façon à assurer la continuité des séries chronologiques sur une base 1961=100. Les indices supplémentaires de prix auparavant publiés et aujourd'hui remplacés allient jusqu'à avril 1973.

(1) Dans cette révision, le panier du consommateur est pondéré d'après les dépenses d'une année plus récente, 1967, et les poids de 1957 sont ainsi remplacés par les poids de 1967 à partir d'avril 1973. Pour une description complète de cette refonte, le lecteur voudra bien se rapporter au bulletin n° 62-539 au catalogue de Statistique Canada intitulé "Indice des prix à la consommation, Canada (1961=100) (révision basée sur les dépenses de 1967)".
