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BASIC UNION WAGE RATES AND INDEXES FOR MAJOR CONSTRUCTION TRADES AND SELECTED CANADIAN CITIES

1961=100

Third, Fourth Quarters and Annual Average, 1972

Construction union wage rates and indexes are presented for the third, fourth quarters and the annual average of 1972. The 14 city composite index rose 2.3 and 2.0 % in the last two quarters of 1972. The annual index rose by 9.4 % to 227.5. This is a smaller increase than the 11.6 % rise recorded in 1971.

A noteworthy change is a return to settlements which averaged less than 5.0 % in 1972 for both Montreal and Regina. As can be seen from the index change table which follows, changes of less than 5.0 % were frequent until 1966. Since then, city indexes rose less than 5.0 % in two instances in 1966 and once in Windsor in 1969. Settlements averaging that size did not reappear until the two observations noted above for 1972. Additionally, settlements of less than 10.0 % occurred in two cities, 8.8 % in Windsor and 8.5 % in Vancouver. Indexes in the remaining 10 cities rose more than 11.0 % or more during the year.

In 10 of the 14 cities the increases were smaller than those recorded in 1971. The most conspicuous decline occurred in Hamilton where the 1972 increase was 11.7 % compared to 24.1 for 1971. That increase was, however, the largest increase recorded in any of the city indexes since 1961.

The four cities in which the indexes exhibited a larger percentage increase in 1972 than in 1971 were Quebec, Saint John and St. John's in the east and Winnipeg in the west.

These varying amounts of index changes for 1971 and 1972 are summarized below in a table which lists the city indexes in rank order. As can be seen, Ottawa, Quebec City and St. John's retained their rank.

Cities which increased their rank were the eastern cities of Saint John and Halifax, the prairie cities of Calgary, Edmonton and Winnipeg and the central cities of Hamilton and Toronto. Montreal, Windsor, Regina and Vancouver all declined in rank.

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TAUX SYNDICAUX DE SALAIRE DE BASE ET INDICES DANS LES PRINCIPAUX CORPS DE MÉTIERS DE LA CONSTRUCTION DANS CERTAINES VILLES CANADIENNES

Troisième et quatrième trimestres, moyenne annuelle, 1972

Les taux syndicaux de salaire et les indices de la construction du troisième et quatrième trimestres et la moyenne annuelle de 1972 portent sur 14 villes. L'indice synthétique a augmenté de 2.3 % et de 2.0 % au cours des deux derniers trimestres de 1972. L'indice annuel s'est accru de 9.4 % pour passer à 227.5, soit une augmentation inférieure à celle enregistrée en 1971 (11.6 %).

Comme changement important, on note le retour à des accords qui ont été en moyenne inférieure à 5.0 % en 1972 à Montréal et à Regina. Comme on peut le voir dans le tableau des variations de l'indice ci-dessous, les variations de moins de 5.0 % ont été fréquentes jusqu'en 1966. Depuis lors, les indices des villes ont augmenté de moins de 5.0 % deux fois en 1966 et une fois à Windsor en 1969. Les accords de cette envergure ne se sont pas reproduits à l'exception des deux cas cités ci-dessous pour 1972. En outre, des accords de moins de 10.0 % sont intervenus dans deux villes, soit 8.8 % à Windsor et 8.5 % à Vancouver. Dans les 10 autres villes, les indices ont augmenté de plus de 11.0 % au cours de l'année.

Dans 10 des 14 villes, l'accroissement a été inférieur à celui enregistré en 1971. La diminution la plus notable s'est produite à Hamilton où l'augmentation a été de 11.7 % en 1972 contre 24.1 % en 1971. Il s'agissait là toutefois de l'accroissement le plus considérable qui ait été enregistré depuis 1961 dans l'indice d'une ville.

Les quatre villes où l'accroissement de l'indice a été plus considérable en 1972 qu'en 1971 sont Québec, Saint-Jean (N.-B.) et St-Jean (T.-N.) dans l'Est et Winnipeg dans l'Ouest.

Ces variations de l'indice pour 1971 et 1972 sont résumées ci-dessous dans un tableau qui donne par ordre d'importance les indices de villes. Comme on peut le voir, Ottawa, Québec et St-Jean n'ont pas changé de rang.

Les villes où l'indice s'est accru sont celles de Saint-Jean et d'Halifax dans l'Est, de Calgary, Edmonton et Winnipeg dans les provinces des Prairies et de Hamilton et Toronto au centre. Les villes de Montréal, Windsor, Regina et Vancouver ont baissé de rang.


A review of the 14 city composite index shows that half of the trade indexes rose between 8.0 or 9.0 % in 1972. With the exception of labourers, which is an important trade, all the larger increases from 10.0 to 16.0 % were associated with trades which have a small index weight. These changes in trade indexes are listed below in their rank order.

Une analyse de l'indice synthétique des 14 villes indique que la moitié des indices des métiers ont augmenté de 8.0 % ou 9.0 % en 1972. À l'exception des manœuvres, qui constituent un groupe important, toutes les grandes augmentations de l'ordre de 10.0 % à 16.0 % se rapportaient aux métiers dont la pondération de l'indice était faible. Ces variations des indices des métiers figurent ci-dessous par ordre d'importance.





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
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
