## ITDEX MTMBERS OF WHOLESALE PRICES, APRI, 1234 , (PRELIMNARY)

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics indox numbor of wholesalo prices on the base, 1926 100, moved down from 72.0 in March to 71.2 in spril. 65 quotations wore higher, 135 were lower while 367 remained unchangod.

Vogetable Products foll from 65.7 to 64.7 owing to prico reductions for wheat, oats, barley, flax, flour, bran, and shorts. Animals and Thoir Products droppod from 69.9 to 67.0 duo largoly to lowor quotations for calvos, hogs, frosh and cured meats, butter and eggs. Fibres, Textiles and Textilo Products movod dom firom 74.2 to 73.8 mainly on account of roductions in tho pricos of rail cotton, silk, Wool and silk fabrics. Mood, Mood Products and Paper changed from 65.7 to 65.6 , declines for codar lumber and groundwood pulp outweighing advances for wrapping papor and pine and spruce lumber. Iron and Its Products at 87.2 woro tho same as in tho provious month. Non-Ferrous Motals and Thoir Products doclincd from 66.1 to 65.7. oasior prices for load, zinc, silvor and aluminium influoncing tho indox moro than advancos for copper, and tin. Nom-Motallic Minerals and Thoir Products wore 85.6 im April as compared with 86.1 in March, mainly because of lower prices for domostic coal. Chemicals and Allicd Products roso from 80.8 to 81.8 , gains for coppor sulphato, zinc oxide and propared paints more than offsetting lossos for auromino, shollac and formaldohyde.
