Index Mumbers of Security Prices, Sales and Values January 1925 = 100

The weighted index number of the 25 best selling industrial and public utility common stocks on the Montreal and Toronto Exchanges, computed by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics, reached a new high level last week being 219 5 as compared with 212.9 for the week ending November 20th. The previous high figure was 213.8 in the first week of October.

The weighted index number of the volume of stocks traded rose from 57.9 to 75.7 and that for the total value of stocks traded from 123.3 to 166.2 for the same period.

Only two out of the twenty-five stocks declined in price. Smelters average rose from \$239.3 to \$250, Quebec Power from \$186.1 to \$196.9, Brazilian from \$102.6 to \$104.4, B.C. Fish from \$92.4 to \$95.5, Shawinigan from \$266.9 to \$271.6, Industrial Alcohol from \$23.1 to \$25.9, Steel of Canada from \$112.4 to \$115.8, Wayagamack from \$108.7 to \$114.5 and Permans from \$178.1 to \$182.4.

Sales were greater for eighteen and smaller for seven stocks. Smelters increased from 6,200 to 17,000, Laurentide from 3,700 to 8,400, Snawinigan from 4,600 to 6,000, Industrial Alcohol from 6,700 to 42,000, Abitibi from 1,100 to 3,100, B.C. Fish fell from 12,500 to 8,900 and Brazilian from 39,000 to 25,000.
