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Index Numbers of Security Prices, Sales and Values

January 1925 - 100

The weighted index number of the 25 best selling industrial and public utility common stocks on the Montreal and Toronto exchanges, computed by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics, rose from 159.9 in the week ending April 3rd to 165.6 during last week.

The weighted index of the volume of stocks traded rose from 56.0 to 82.8 and the index number of total values of the stocks traded from 89.5 to 137.1 in the same period.

Sixteen of the twenty-five best selling stocks showed higher average prices, two were lower and seven were practically unchanged. The chief influences in raising the index number of prices were Brazilian which went up three points on the average, Smelters with a rise of over nine points and Montreal Light. Heat and Power which was up seven and one-half points. Shawinigan was up four points.

The sales of fourteen stocks increased, for eight stocks there was a decrease and three others were about the same. The chief influence in raising the index of sales were Brazilian and Montreal Light Heat and Power. Smelter sales were at a lower level but higher prices about offset the reduction in sales. Canada Cement and B. C. Fishing also increased their sales considerably.
