Index Numbers of Security Prices, Sales and Values January 1925 = 100

The weighted index number of the 25 best selling industrial and Public Utility common stocks on the Montreal and Toronto exchanges, computed by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics, showed a further increase last week, being 176.7 as compared with 175.3 for the week ending June 26th.

The weighted index number of the volume of stocks traded fell from 38.3 to 33.3 and that for total value of stocks traded from 67.1 to 58.3.

Fifteen of the twenty-five stocks had higher average prices and ten were lower. The most important increases were for Smelters, which rose from 209.0 to 212.8, and for Shawinigan, which was 205.4 as against 199.4 last week. Brazilian declined from 97.5 to 97.0 and Montreal Light, Heat and Power from 227.4 to 225.8.

Sales were higher for seventeen stocks and lower for eight but the amount of the declines more than counterbalanced the increases. Sales of Brazilian fell off from 13,495 to 7,595, Montreal Light, Heat and Power from 5,637 to 2,575 a d B. C. Fish from 5,360 to 300. Smelters sales were 5,024 as compared with 2,236 last week and Abitibi 5,250 as compared with 390.
