Index Numbers of Security Prices, Sales and Values January 1925 - 100

The weighted index number of the 25 best selling industrial and public utility common stocks on the Montreal and Toronto exchanges computed by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics dropped to 211.2 for the week ending September 18th from 212.0 for the preceding weak.

The weighted index number of the volume of stocks traded fell from 87,2 to 70.1 and that for the total value of stocks traded, from 184.9 to 148.0 for the same

Sixteen stocks were lower in price and nine were higher. Brazilian declined from 118.1 to 115.3, Smelters from 252.0 to 244.1 and Spanish River from 110.2 to 108.9. Industrial Alcohol rose from 21.6 to 23.3. Quebec Power from 136.6 to 149.4 and Wagamack from 95.0 to 99.3

Salas wars greater for thirteen stocks and lower for twelve but the decreases cutweighted the increases in importance. Sale of Brazilian fell from 32,000 to 27,000 Brewaries from 33,000 to 11,000, Montreal Light, Heat and Power from 38,000 to 22,000 and Spanish River from 7,000 to 2,000. Smelters sales rose from 11,000 to 12,000, Law entide from 13,000 to 16,000 and Shawinigan from 1,500 to 2,600
