Index Numbers of Security Prices, Sales and Values January 1925 = 100

The weighted index number of the 25 best selling industrial and public utility common stocks on the Montreal and Toronto Exchanges computed by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics remained stationary last week at 206.4.

The weighted index number of the volume of stocks traded declined from 161.1 to 76.0 and that for the total value of stocks traded from 332.5 to 156.9

Twenty-one stocks were higher in price and four were lower. The most important increases were Smelters from 239.9 to 248.0, Montreal Light, Heat and Power (new) from 65.8 to 67.1 and Abitibi from 88.0 to 90.0. Brazilian declined from 117.8 to 116.4 and Laurentide from 103.4 to 102.0

Sales were greater for fifteen stocks and smaller for ten. The declines, however, much more than counterbalanced the increases. Sales of Brazilian declined from 108,406 to 25,661, Twin City from 48,584 to 1,276, Laurentide from 29,303 to 5,624, National Breweries from 35,814 to 12,775 and Shawinigan from 6,409 to 1,395. Sales of Smelters rose from 17,345 to 19,048 and those of Can. Ind. Alcohol from 7,863 to 19,282.
