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INDEX NUMBERS OF SECURITY PRICES, SALES AND VALUES January 1925 = 100

The weighted index number of the twenty-five best selling industrial and public utility common stocks on the Montreal and Toronto Exchanges, computed by the ominion Bureau of Statistics, was 471.7 last week as compared with 472.9 for the Mak ending October 22nd.

The weighted index number of the volume of stocks traded rose from 63.5 to 77.9 and that for the total value of stocks traded from 300.3 to 367.4.

Average prices were higher for twelve, lower for twelve and unchanged for one of the twenty-five stocks. Brazilian fell from \$197.6 to \$194.2, International Nickel from \$67.0 to \$64.3, Smelters from \$250.0 to \$245.4 and Steel of Canada from \$169.4 to \$165.3. Brompton rose from \$48.7 to \$56.1, Spanish River from \$125.0 to \$128.7, National Breweries from \$88.8 to \$93.3, City Dairy from \$191.4 to \$197.2 and Wayagamack from \$92.6 to \$99.8.

Sales were larger for fifteen and smaller for ten stocks. Brazilian went up from 67,900 to 83,600, International Nickel from 27,900 to 54,400, Laurentide from 5,000 to 10,400, Brompton from 12,100 to 21,400. Abitibi sales fell off from 13,300 to 9,600, Smelters from 6,000 to 4,400, Dominion Bridge from 5,000 to 3,300 and Asbestos Corporation from 11,500 to 3,300.
