INDEX NUMBERS OF SECURITY PRICES, SALES AND VALUES January 1925 = 100

The weighted index number of the 25 best celling industrial and public utility common stocks on the Montreal and Toronto Exchanges computed by the Dominian Bureau of Statistics was 249.4 for the week ending February 19th having risen 5.9% above the level of the previous week when the index was 21+3.5

The weighted index number of the volume of stocks traded fell from 76.9 to 48.3 and that for the total value of stocks traded from 187.2 to 120.5.

Average prices were higher for twenty of the twenty-five stocks, lower for four and unchanged for one. Dominion Bridge rose from \$134.0 to \$144.5, Massey-Harris from \$87.3 to \$92.9, Bell Telephone from \$139.9 to \$149.6, Arnold from \$18.4 to \$23.6, International Nickel from \$41.3 to \$43.0 and Montreal Light, Heat and Power from \$71.7 to \$73.0. Smelters declined from \$247.6 to \$245.2.

Sales were greater for fifteen stocks and lower for ten, but the decreases outweighed the increases in importance. Brazilian sales declined from 54,300 to 11,300, Massey-Harris from 34,400 to 14,300, Quebec Power from 8,500 to 1,700 Laurentide from 9,200 to 5,211, B.C. Fish from 12,600 to 8,400 and Industrial Alcohol from 23,300 to 10,000. Bell Telephone sales were up from 605 to 4,400, Montreal Light, Heat and Power from 6,300 to 10,300, International Nickel from 4,400 to 12,500 and Abition from 1,400 to 5,100 4,400 to 12,500 and Abitibi from 1:400 to 5,100.
