Bell Telephone from $\$ 139.9$ to $\$ 149.6$. Arno id from $\$ 18.4$ to $\$ 23.6$, Internationai Nickel from $\$ 41.3$ to $\$ 43.0$ and Montreal Iight, Heat and Pomer from $\$ 71.7$ to $\$ 73.0$. Smelters declined from $\$ 247.6$ to $\$ 21.5 .2$.

Sales were greater for fifteen stocks and lower for tey, but the decrenses outreighed the increases in importance. Brazilian sales declined from 54,300 to 11,300, Massey-Marris from 34,400 to 14,300 , Quebec Power from 8.500 to 1,700 Laurentide from 9,200 to 5,241, B.C. Fish. from 12,600 to 8,400 and Industrial Alcohol from 23,300 to 10,000. Bcll Tel ephone sales were up from 605 to 4,400 , Montreal Light, Heat and Power from 6, goo oo Ir: 3c0, International Nickel from 4,400 to 12,500 and Abitivi from 1:400 to 5,100 .
