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## INDEX MUMBERS OF SECURITY PRICE, SALS AND VALUES <br> January $1925=100$

The weighted index number of the tmenty-five best selling industrial and public utility common stocks on the Nontreal and Toronto Exchanges, computed by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics, was 362,2 last week as compared rith 355.8 for the week onding June 11th.

The reighted index number of the volume of stocks traded fel from 99.2 to 75.6 and that for the totel value of stocks traded from 352.9 to 273.8 .

Average prices were lower for fourteen higher for nine and unchanged for two of the twenty-five stocks. The increases outneighed the decreases in importance, Brazilian, which dominated the market movement, rose from $\$ 161.2$ to $\$ 167.3$. Stecl of Canada rose from $\$ 133.6$ to $\$ 135.8$ and City Dairy from $\$ 116.6$ to $\$ 123.0$. Smelters declined from $\$ 248.1$ to $\$ 241.1$, Nickel from $\$ 69.0$ to $\$ 66.8$. Shavinigan from $\$ 59.7$ to $\$ 88.4$ and Seagram from $\$ 26.1$ to $\$ 24.6$.

Salcs were smaller for fifteen and greater for ten stocks. Brazilian mere dorn from 135,900 to 100,400 , Dominion Bridge from 9,300 to 3,500 , National Breweries from 15,700 to 4,400 and Sharinigan from 15,800 to 8,900 . Intermational Nickel wore up from 41,400 to 49,500 and Massey-Herris from 25,600 to 35,700 .
