The weighted index number of the twenty-five best selling industrial and public utility common stocks on the Montreal and Toronto Exchanges, computed by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics, fell nearly fifteen points last week, being 347.3 as compared with 362.2 for the week ending June 13th.

The weighted index number of the volume of stocks traded fell from 75.6 to 67.0 and that for the total value of stocks traded from 273.8 to 232.7.

Average prices were lower for twenty-three, higher for one and unchanged for one of the twenty-five stocks. Brazilian declined from \$167.3 to \$159.7, International Nickel from \$66.8 to \$62.7 and Massey-Harris from \$39.4 to \$36.1. Less important declines were: Shawinigan from \$88.4 to \$85.4, Seagram from \$24.6 to \$22.1, National Breweries from \$70.4 to \$68.3. Quebec Power from \$290.2 to \$279.9, Smelters from \$241.1 to \$235.3 and Canada Cement from \$150.7 to \$146.2.

Sales were greater for thirteen and smaller for twelve stocks but the latter exerted the greatest influence on the index. Brazilian were down from 100,400 to 86,100, Nickel from 49,500 to 31,800, Massey-Harris from 35,700 to 24,500, National Breweries from 4,400 to 1,300 and Winnipeg Electric from 3,300 to 1250. Sales of Smelters were up from 3,200 to 5,400, Quebec Power from 550 to 2,200, Montreal Light, Heat and Power from 6,000 to 7,800 and Shawinigan from 8,900 to 10,600.
