INDEX NUMBERS OF SECURITY PRICES, SALES AND VALUES January 1925 = 100

The weighted index numbers of the twenty-five best colling industrial and public utility common stocks on the Montreal and Toronto Exchanges, computed by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics was 358.7 last week as compared with 344.8 for the week ending July 23rd.

The weighted index number of the volume of stocks traded fell from 39.5 to 36.4 and that for the total value of stocks traded from 139.8 to 130.6.

Average prices were higher for nineteen and lower for six of the twenty-five stocks. Brazilian rose from \$166.3 to \$169, Industrial Alcohol from \$32.5 to \$33.7 Laurentide \$95.2 to \$96.5 and Abitibi from \$92.3 to 39.7. International Nickel declined from \$61.6 to to \$59.3.

Sales were greater for fourteen and smaller for cleven stocks but the decreases outweighed the increases in importance. Abitibi dropped from 9500 to 1500, Montreal Light Heat and Power Company from 19,400 to 6,300, Laurentide from 5,800 to 3,000, Dominion Bridge from 2,200 to 350, Shawinigan from 7,400 to 4,100 and Spanish River from 1,500 to 600. Sales of Smelters rose from 1,025 to 3,400, Brazilian from 50,600 to 52,300 and International Nickel from 2,300 to 7,900.
