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INDEX NUMBERS OF SECURITY PRICES, SALES AND VALUES January 1925 = 100

The weighted index number of the twenty-five best selling industrial and public utility common stocks on the Montreal and Toronto Exchanges computed by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics rose 8.7 points last week being 400.2 as compared with 391.5 for the week ending August 27th.

The weighted index number of the volume of stocks traded fell from 71.4 to 47.5 and that for the total value of stocks traded from 279.5 to 190.1.

Average prices were higher for seventeen stocks, lower for seven and unchanged for one. Brazilian was up from \$177.1 to \$183.2, Canada Cement from \$174.5 to \$185.3, Shawinigan from \$87.1 to \$88.3 and 'uebec Power (old) from \$285.4 to \$293.2. International Nickel fell from \$67.8 to \$66.8 and Laurentide from \$95.9 to \$94.2.

Sales were smaller for seventeen and greater for eight stocks. Smelters declined from 24,200 to 4,300 National Breweries from 22,700 to 7,800, Dominion Bridge from 6,400 to 2,200, Shawinigan from 21,900 to 14,200 and Steel of Canada from 5,300 to 2,300. Sal of Quebec Power (old) were up from 1,380 to 2,900, Abitibi from 1,600 to 3,600 and Wayagamack from 1,680 to 3,960.
